## MONASTIC CELLAR

## 1900S

Step into a setting that recreates the early days of beer production and distribution at the beginning of the 20th century. Experience the atmosphere of a brewing laboratory filled with glassware, pipettes, flasks, and countless bottles and jars. Touch the grains of malt, barley, and hops, explore the secrets of fermentation, and witness the manual rituals of labeling, capping, and distribution. A sensory journey that brings back to life the alchemy of beer from another era.
